We surveyed over 1,000 employees around Australia across multiple industries including **Education | Construction | Professional Services | Healthcare | Government** to find out how COVID-19 has impacted the way they work.

55% of employees we surveyed **planned to work from home**.



Of these only:

1 in 3 (33%)

were fully prepared to work from home.



Just **over half (55%)** were only somewhat prepared.

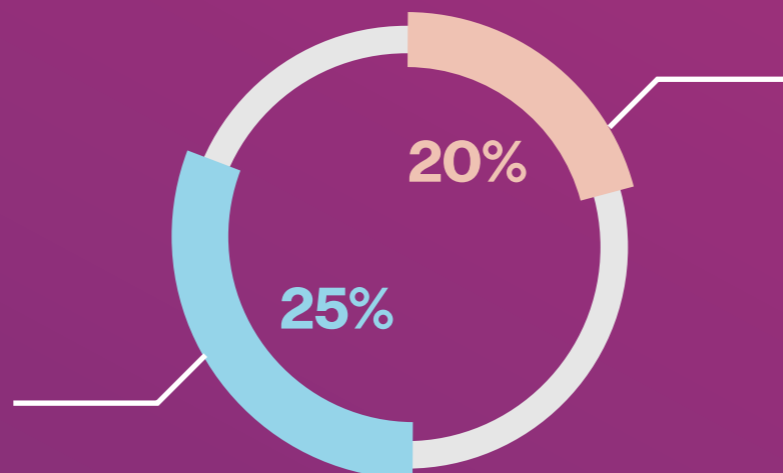


Approximately **1 in 10 (12%)** were not prepared at all.



In conclusion, we found:

Only **25%** of those surveyed said they would continue to work on-site, leaving these employees at risk of coming into contact with the virus.



Another **20%** said they were unable to work from home, highlighting the absolute necessity for stronger contingency plans in times of crisis.

We discovered that only **55% of employees in the Education sector** felt prepared or somewhat prepared to teach from home. We've identified the **most valuable tools and equipment** that employees working in the Education sector can use, whether they're working on-site or from home.
